

## RULES FOR TRIANGLE COMPETITION

**Epsom Movie Makers, Orpington Video & Film Makers,  
and Spring Park Film Makers**

### Format

At each round of the competition one of these clubs will act as host and the others will each compete by providing a programme of 30 minutes MAXIMUM duration. The competition will be judged on the basis of PROGRAMME ENTERTAINMENT value.

The judges will view each programme in its entirety, without any pauses for making comments.

### Rules

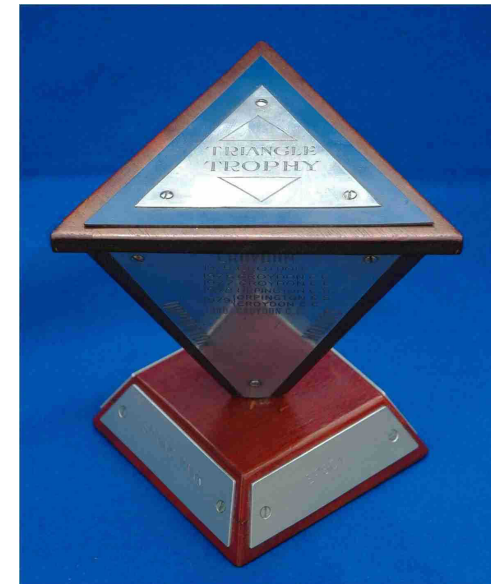
1. The venue will rotate so that each year a different club will act as host and will provide a meeting place, simple refreshments, screen, speakers, projector stands and means to show films. The host club will also provide three judges conversant with the rules, and, if desired, a timer for notifying when the 30 minute limit is up.
2. Each programme should be of films on current formats made by members of the competing clubs, either individually or in groups, which have been made within two years of the previous competition date.
3. Each programme must be on DVD, Blu-ray disc or video files on USB pen drive and should be brought on standard equipment: clubs are advised to bring their own DVD player and projector. All equipment has been tested, as back-up. If a club chooses to put a programme on a Blu-ray disc (eg to show in HD), THEY MUST BRING A DVD player.
4. At the end of the final programme the judges will announce and comment on their choice of the MOST ENTERTAINING PROGRAMME and the BEST MOVIE and may further comment on a maximum of three movies from the programme.
5. The Triangle Trophy will be awarded to the club with the most entertaining programme and the Croydon Trophy will be awarded to the maker of the best film in the competition.
6. Please remember that all audio and visual copyrights are the responsibility of the film-makers.
7. Each competing club is to send a list of Titles and Running Times to the host club at least TWO WEEKS BEFORE THE EVENT. Their show-reel should be included with the list, to facilitate checking projection on the host club's equipment.
8. The host club will revise these rules as necessary and remind participating clubs of these rules each year.
9. Engraving and costs of this are the responsibility of the clubs receiving awards.
